PRODUCTION

Safedrop tools are produced together with one of the leading mechanical workshops in the west of Norway.

The tools are cut with water in ergonomically optimal locations. Connecting rings of acid-proof, corrosion resistant steel provide the link between tools and wires. These rings are formed in a lathe, cut and widened and finally TIGwelded onto the individual tool before polishing.

The water cutting ensures that the integrity of the metal is preserved and avoids brittleness and cracking.
